### **Conclusion:**

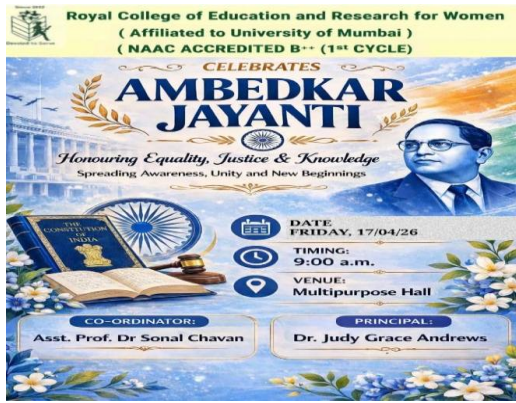
