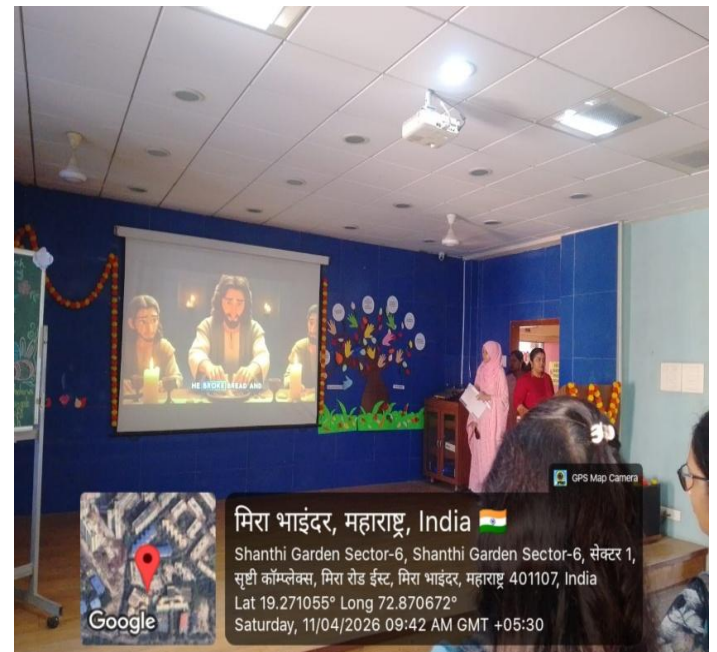
#### **Aratreka Dutta (F.Y.B.Ed.):**
