### Report of Community work (2016-18)

Community service is a non paying work that is performed by a person for the benefit of her/his local community. Community service at B.Ed is voluntary service providing students with an opportunity to explore ways to enhance community life. Its main objective is to create awareness of the importance of voluntarism it is also directed to acquaint students with the community diversity. By keeping all objectives in mind Royal College of Education and Research for women conducted 6 days community service in collaboration with NGO "Bright Future Welfare Association" situated at Mira Road (E). The main objectives of community service are as follows:-

- To enhance students learning by enabling them to practice skills and test classroom knowledge through related local service in the local community.
- To enable students to provide needed assistance to community agencies and to the people served by the agencies.
- To increase social awareness and responsibility.
- To facilitate and assist faculty in their roles as facilitators of service learning and in their engagement with the community.
- To build qualities of leadership, problem solving, collaboration with others, time management and communication skill.
- To develop a culture and ethos of service among student-teachers to exercise responsibility and to develop leadership skills by resolving real life problems.
- To provide opportunities to student teachers to gain first hand experiences by helping other.
- To sensitize the future teachers towards the contemporary issues.

4<sup>th</sup> December 2017, **Door to Door survey** was conducted where all students had to collect family survey from different societies.

6<sup>th</sup> December 2017, students **created awareness and distributed sanitary pads free of cost** in slum areas like Azad Nagar and Shastri Nagar at Mira-Bhayander

7<sup>th</sup> December 2017, **Each one Teach one** was organized in the NGO "**Bright Future Welfare Association**" where nursery children who come from slum areas, they were taught for a whole day by using different methods by the B.Ed students

8<sup>th</sup> December 2017, **Visiting Old age Home** where B.Ed students visited two old age homes that is Krishna Kala trust Old age Home and Kayanath Old Age Home at Mira Road

9<sup>th</sup> December 2017, **Shramdan** was conducted at Royal Girls Urdu School where all students participated in it.

We were not able to go ahead with the programme as scheduled because it rained heavily on one of the days that is 5<sup>th</sup> of December 2017. In place of the missed day we arranged community service in an old age home at Vasai (**Dadasaheb Tatke Vrudhashram**).
