Community Work Report (2019-2020)

“Service to others is the rent you pay for your room here on Earth”.

Community service is the work performed by a person or group of people for the benefit and betterment of their community. It is one of the requirements of the University of Mumbai that the students put in 36 hours in 6 days in rendering service to the community. Marks are allotted to them on the basis of the work done and reported to the college. Royal College of Education and Research for women conducted 6 days community service in collaboration with “**Mira Bhayander Municipal Corporation Schools**” in Mira **Bhayander** (Miragoan, Kashigaon, Miraroad station and Bhayander- west) during the academic year **2019-2020**. The main objectives of community service are as follows:-

To enhance students learning by enabling them to practice skills and test classroom knowledge through related local service in the local community.

- To enable students to provide needed assistance to community agencies and to the people served by the agencies.
- To increase social awareness and responsibility.
- To facilitate and assist faculty in their roles as facilitators of service learning and in their engagement with the community.
- To build qualities of leadership, problem solving, collaboration with others, time management and communication skill.
- To develop a culture and ethos of service among student-teachers to exercise responsibility and to develop leadership skills by resolving real life problems.
- To provide opportunities to student teachers to gain first hand experiences by helping other.
- To sensitize the future teachers towards the contemporary issues.

➤ *Group Division*

All the students of academic year 2019-2020 participated in the community work. 85 students (F.Y.B.Ed.-37 students, S.Y.B.Ed.- 48 students) for a period of 6 hours for 6 days completed their total 36 hours during this period(16/12/2019 to 21/12/2019). MBMC had granted permission in four schools of Mira Bhayander and the 85 students were divided as follows:

➤ *Six days community service activities*

During this period in each school our B.Ed. Trainee Teachers conducted large number of curricular and extracurricular activities along with regular teaching sessions. The students were guided to conduct the following activities during the 6 days community service week according to the school time table. Prior permission was taken and discussed with the school in charges for the same. The school heads had made arrangements in the time table for the same.

The activities conducted during this period were as follows:

- Attending and Organizing Morning Assembly
- Teaching Sessions
- Handling of Value Education Classes, Art and Craft/ Organization of CCA like Quiz, Sports, Cultural Programmes /Games/ Decorating the Notice Board/ Walls.
- Preparations of Learning Resources
- Poster Making & Slogan Writing on any one Theme Peace/ Unity/ National Integration
- Any one of Poster Making / Slogan Writing and Skit on Theme “Tobacco Free School”
- Cleanliness Drive (Awareness Program)
- Life Contribution of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar.

Besides these activities the students were permitted to plan more according to the need of the schools. The students got experience of serving the Mid- Day meal to the students. The Miragoan group had also conducted Exhibition of Art and Craft in the school vicinity.

The overall experience was very memorable for the students. They had got new experiences and also realized that how important is it to support the community in order to make the people in society independent in future. Many students beside these 6 days continued to give some hours as required for the support and excellence of the students.
