The Department of Lifelong Learning & Extension (DLLE) has been recognized as a Statutory Department of the University of Mumbai since 1994. It aims to promote a sustained rapport between the University & the Community. The Extension dimension of the Department facilitates the sensitization of the students to the socio-cultural and environmental realities. The department offers extension work projects encompassing social issues to the students.

Royal College of Education and Research for Women has been enrolling its students for the DLLE Programme since past 3 years. The College enrolled students under: "Environmental Education (EE)" for the academic year 2023-24. The purpose of EE is to educate the present generation about Environment management and sustainability for a better quality of life of their own and for their future generations.

The Department was spearheaded by the enthusiastic Professor Shaista Shaikh for the year 2023-24. To ensure efficiency in the execution of the extension work & to assist the teachers in the work involved, the extension activity of the Student Managers was felt pivotal. The pillars of the department (Student Managers) were: Ms. Niomy Garya & Ms. Riya Upadhyay of S.Y.B.Ed. and Ms. Riya Diwedi & Ms. Atiya Mulani of F.Y.B.Ed.

The Extension work teacher and students attend the Extension work Training Program to implement activities also receive guidance under the Field Coordinators. During this entire program, Student Teachers collaborate with different organizations and perform activities on College as well Community level and note it down in the form of a report which is then submitted to the department of DLLE.

After the orientation and with the reception of the circular from the university to enroll students, the Department of Life Long Learning & Extension (DLLE) of our college began the process of enrollment and we enrolled a total of 45 students for the academic year 2023-2024.

As per the University circular most of the extension activities were conducted in offline mode. We had our First Term Training Program Orientation at Tolani College, Andheri. After that we conducted the training program in our B.Ed. college for the students by our Professor to

encourage students to join DLLE we made a promotion ppt that reflected on the activities undertaken by the students under DLLE program thus far which was well appreciated by our Field Coordinator.

The Extension work teachers and students attended the Extension work Training

Program to implement activities. The program was held on 8th December, 2023 which was hosted by Sahyadri Shikshan Seva Mandal School & College, Naigaon (East). Our Field Coordinator Dr.Manisha Gawde addressed & guided our extension students in both the terms. Her valuable guidance helped the students in completing their project work.
