

By planting over 63,000 trees, he has amplified the green cover of Mumbai, which has earned him the title of 'The Green Man.' He is on a mission to address all those issues which are crucial for retaining the natural resources of planet Earth and tree plantation is one of these. His mission of life is to inspire every individual to generate his oxygen by planting a tree today. In his opinion, without planting trees an individual does not have the right to breathe.

The talk conducted by Subhajit sir was very informative. He talked about the ways to create a green and healthy environment and gave us information about recyclable and non-recyclable waste material. He spoke about the harmful plastic materials and how it is disposed in the water bodies and consumed by water animals. We were informed about recycling plastic bottles and cans into flower pots or other decoration materials that can be placed around the house. There was also an interactive session where we discussed the situation in our surroundings and the government measures taken to control pollution.
