### **A. Pre-Placement Training**



#### **1. Polish & Shine- Grooming Workshop held on 08-02-2025:**

#### 4. Workshop on Resume Writing held on 07-03-2025



### **On-Campus Placement- Dalmia Academy held on 31-01-2025:**



