

COMMUNITY REMEDIAL REPORT 2024-25

Community Remedial Support is to help and support to a special needs student named Maliha during her study sessions. The sessions were planned to help her understand different school subjects like History, English, Sociology, Economics, and Physical Education.

Objective

- To support Maliha in her studies by understanding her needs and teaching her in ways that suited her best.
- To use simple methods like reading aloud, explaining in Hindi, and repeating lessons to help her understand better.
- To make sure she understood each subject well by asking questions, giving exercises, and reviewing the lessons.
- To help her prepare for exams by solving multiple choice questions, fill-in-the-blanks, and revising important topics.
- To make learning easy and comfortable for her so she could ask questions and stay involved in the sessions.

Learning Outcomes for the Student Teacher

1. Learned how to **adjust teaching methods** for a special needs student.
2. Became more **patient and understanding** while teaching.
3. Improved ability to **communicate clearly** using simple language.
4. Gained experience in **inclusive and supportive teaching**.

Overall, the aim was to help Maliha learn better and feel more confident in her studies, even with the challenges she faces.

Reflection

Thursday (27/06/24)

Timing: 10:45 AM – 12:00 PM

I began the session by trying to understand what the student needed to learn and how she preferred to learn. Since she is visually impaired and has some difficulty with hearing, I spoke to her in a louder voice and dictated words clearly. I started with History (Class 12 Arts), covering Chapter 1: *"Renaissance in Europe and Development in Sciences."* I completed two short notes during this session and successfully achieved the day's objectives.

Friday (28/06/24)

Timing: 10:30 AM – 11:30 AM

I was assigned to teach her English. As she is a special needs student, I read aloud and explained the first chapter to her. We discussed true/false questions and some comprehension-based queries. She grasped the content quickly, though her limited English proficiency made the explanation a bit challenging.

Saturday (29/06/24)

Timing: 10:30 AM – 11:30 AM

Monday (01/07/24)

Timing: 10:30 AM – 11:30 AM

I was assigned to teach Sociology to Maliha. I began with a brief introduction to Chapter 1 and then explained the Vedic period, focusing on their beliefs, practices, and women's participation during that era. She asked several questions, which I initially explained in her mother tongue (Hindi) and then translated into English. I concluded the session by reviewing all the content and asking topic-related questions to reinforce her understanding.

Tuesday (02/07/24)

Timing: 10:30 AM – 11:30 AM

I continued with Sociology. I read out the questions and answers from Chapter 1, helping her memorize the key points. I translated the answers into Hindi to ensure better comprehension. Before ending the session, I conducted a quick revision, and she was able to answer all the questions confidently.

Wednesday (03/07/24)

Timing: 10:30 AM – 11:30 AM

Since her exams were approaching, she requested to study Economics. I taught her the first chapter: *"Introduction to Micro and Macro Economics."* I explained the chapter thoroughly and helped her practice multiple-choice questions by guiding her through the correct answers.

Thursday (04/07/24)

Timing: 10:30 AM – 11:30 AM

I was assigned to teach Physical Education. I read and explained the sentences to her. We worked on fill-in-the-blanks and match-the-column exercises. She understood the material quickly, although her difficulty with English made the explanation a bit more demanding.

Friday (05/07/24)

Timing: 10:30 AM – 11:30 AM

As her exam was scheduled for that day, I helped her revise the MCQs from Economics. I ensured she understood everything thoroughly and completed a final revision of all the topics covered.
