Use of Technology in Education: Understood how digital tools can improve lesson planning, assessment, and student engagement.

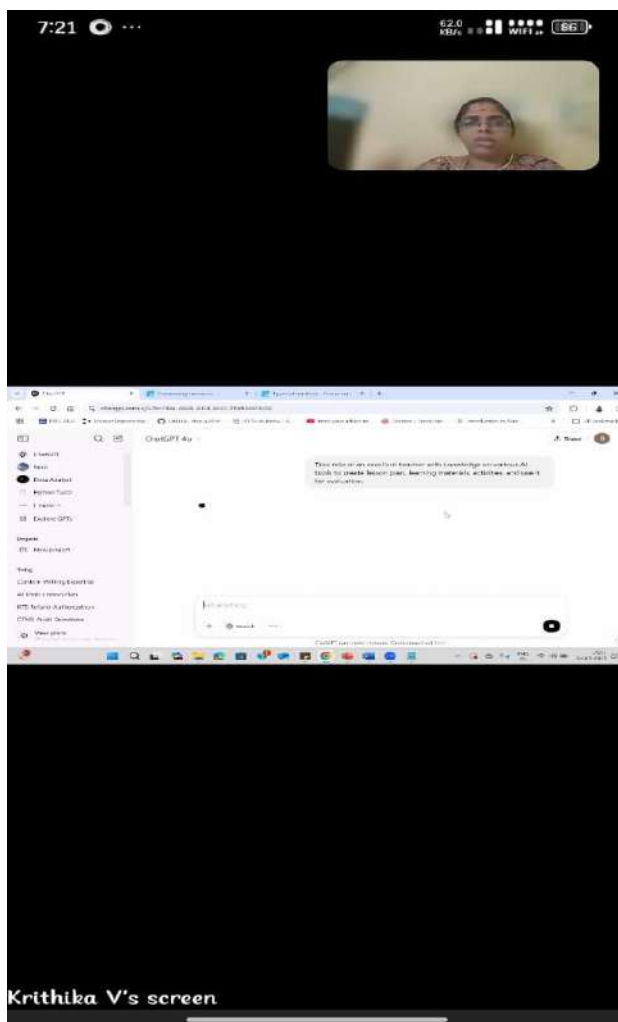
