REFLECTION:

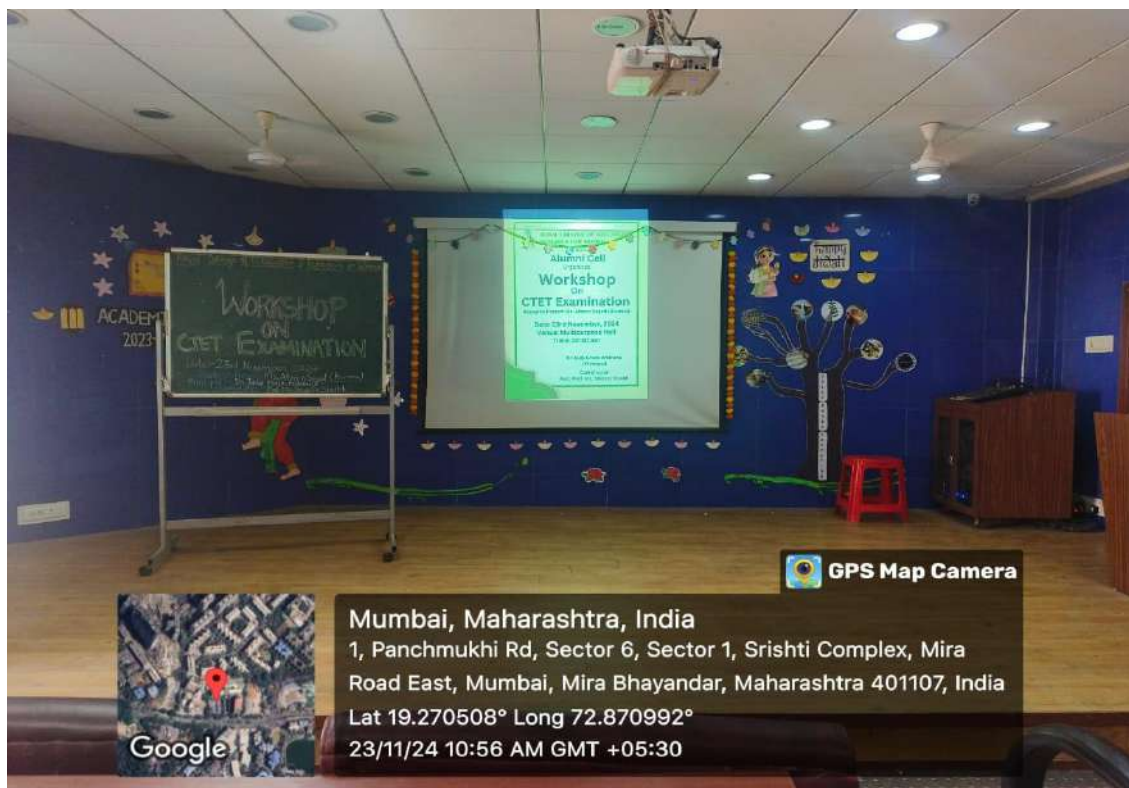

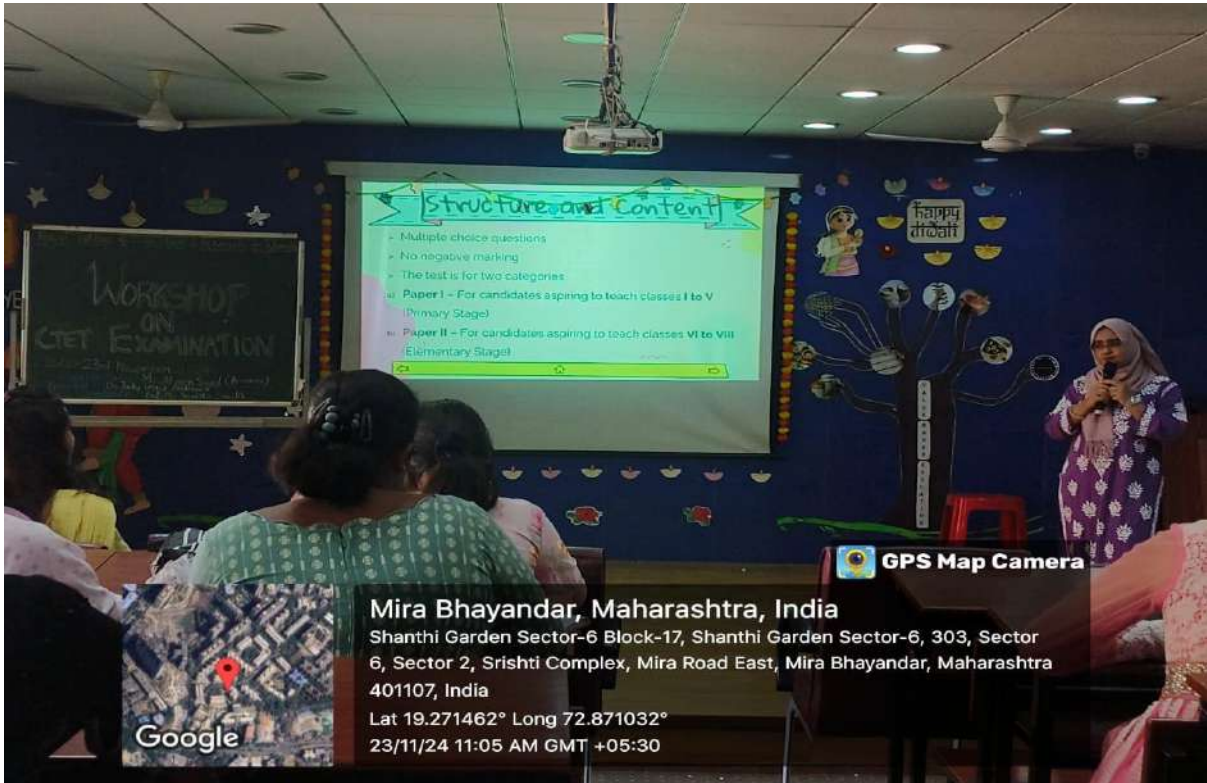
