Introduction:



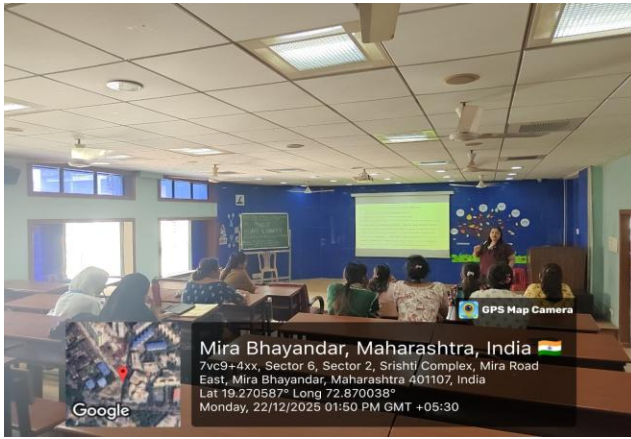
