Introduction:

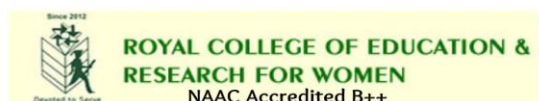

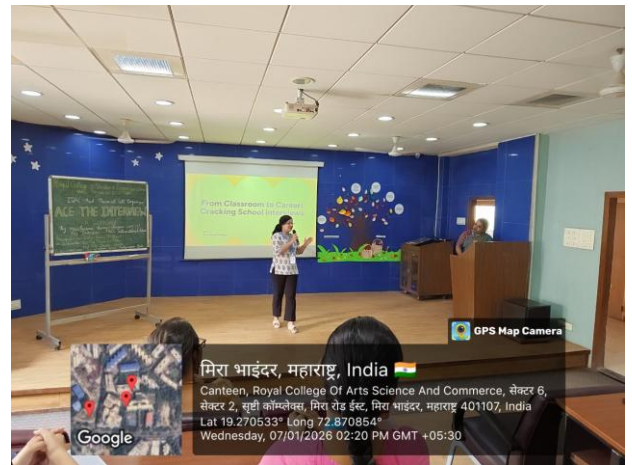

- **Workshop on CTET Examination held on 19-01-2026**

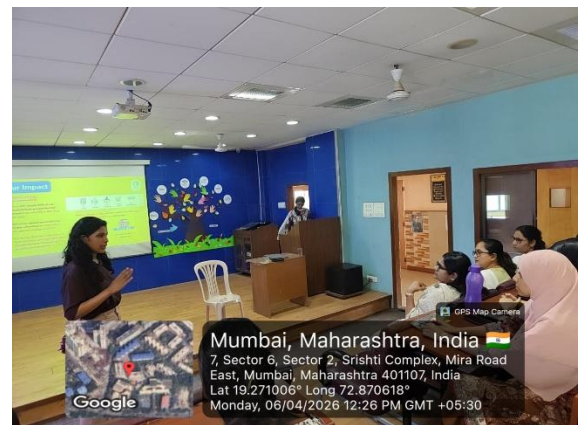

On-Campus Placement- iTeach Schools held on 06-04-2026:

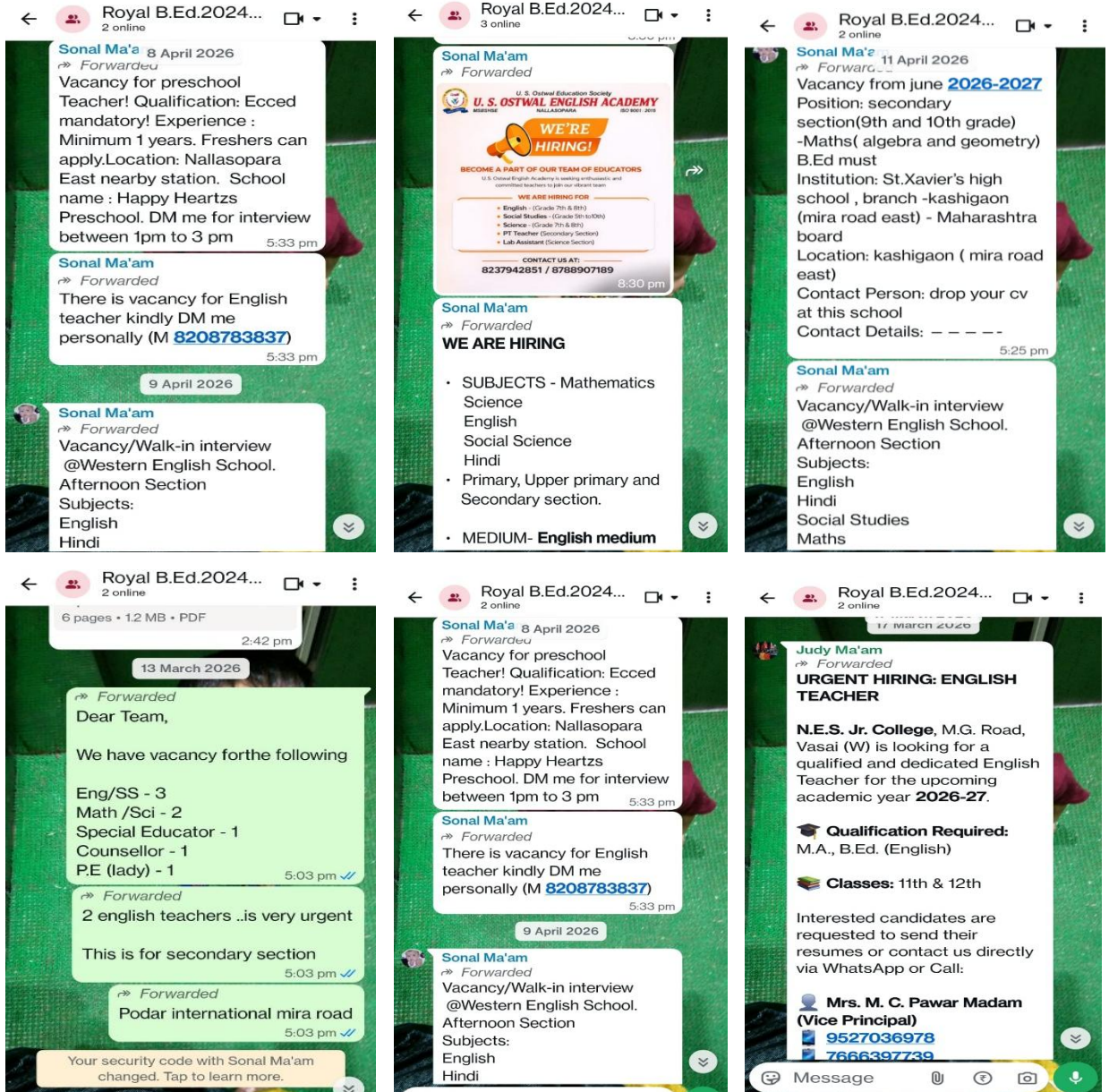
