REFLECTION:

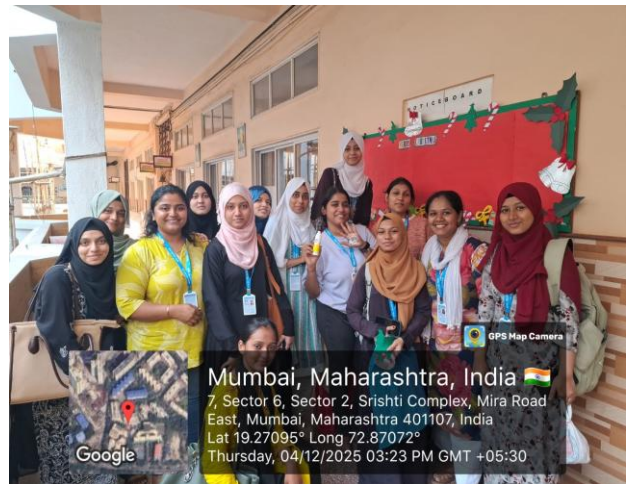
