### Learning Outcomes:

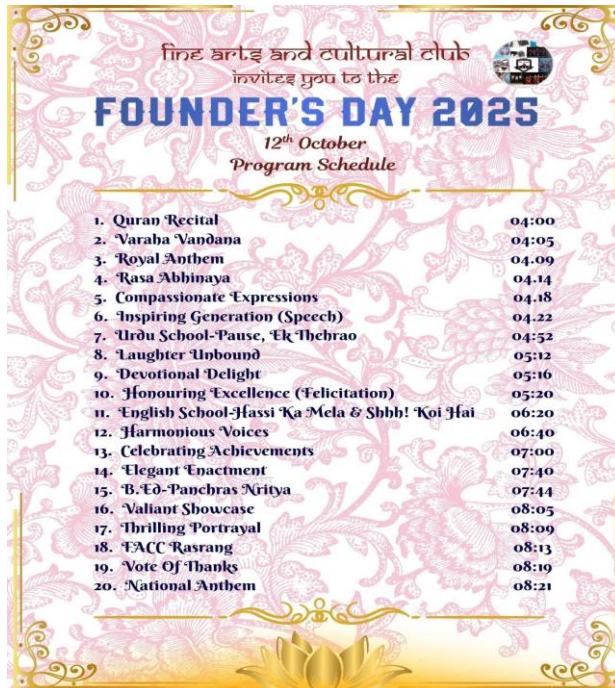
1. Students developed confidence, stage presence, and communication skills.
