Kashish - The programme was well-structured and maintained a meaningful flow.

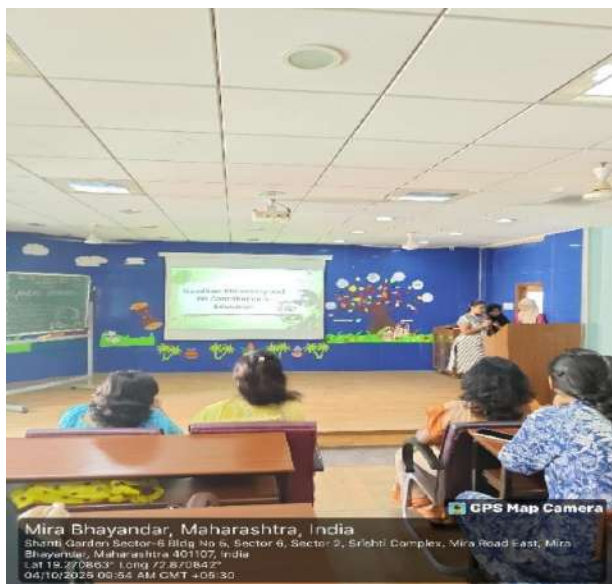
