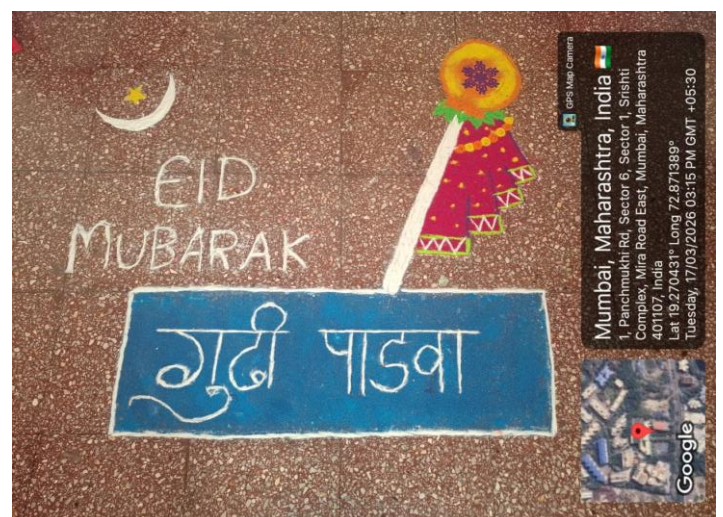
### Aratreka Dutta (F.Y.B.Ed.):

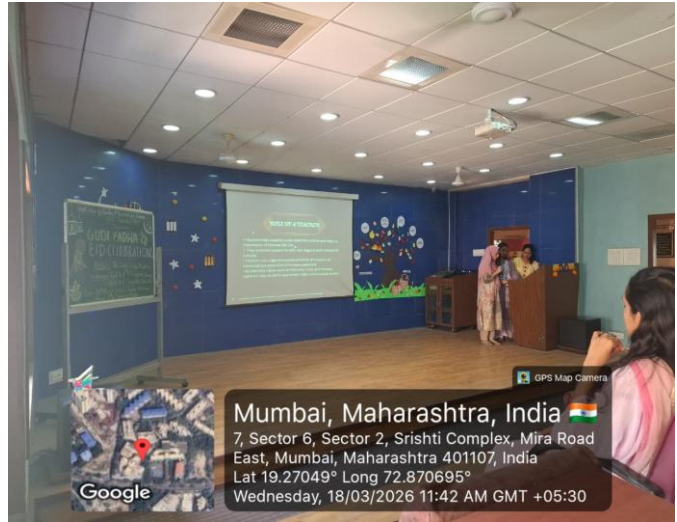
This celebration made learning interesting and meaningful. We learned the importance of respecting all religions and celebrating festivals together with joy and harmony.

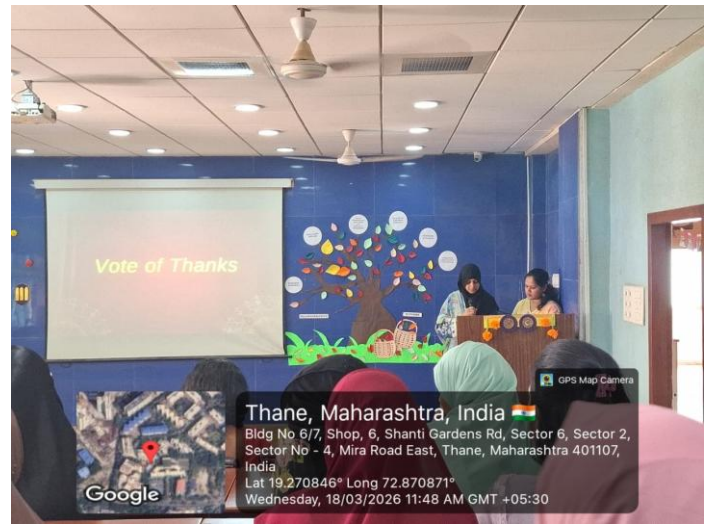
## Learning Outcomes
