1. To understand the structure and eligibility criteria of the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET).
2. To gain clarity about Paper I and Paper II, syllabus, and marking scheme prescribed by Central Board of Secondary Education.
3. To develop effective preparation strategies and time management skills for competitive examinations.
4. To create awareness about career opportunities after qualifying CTET.
