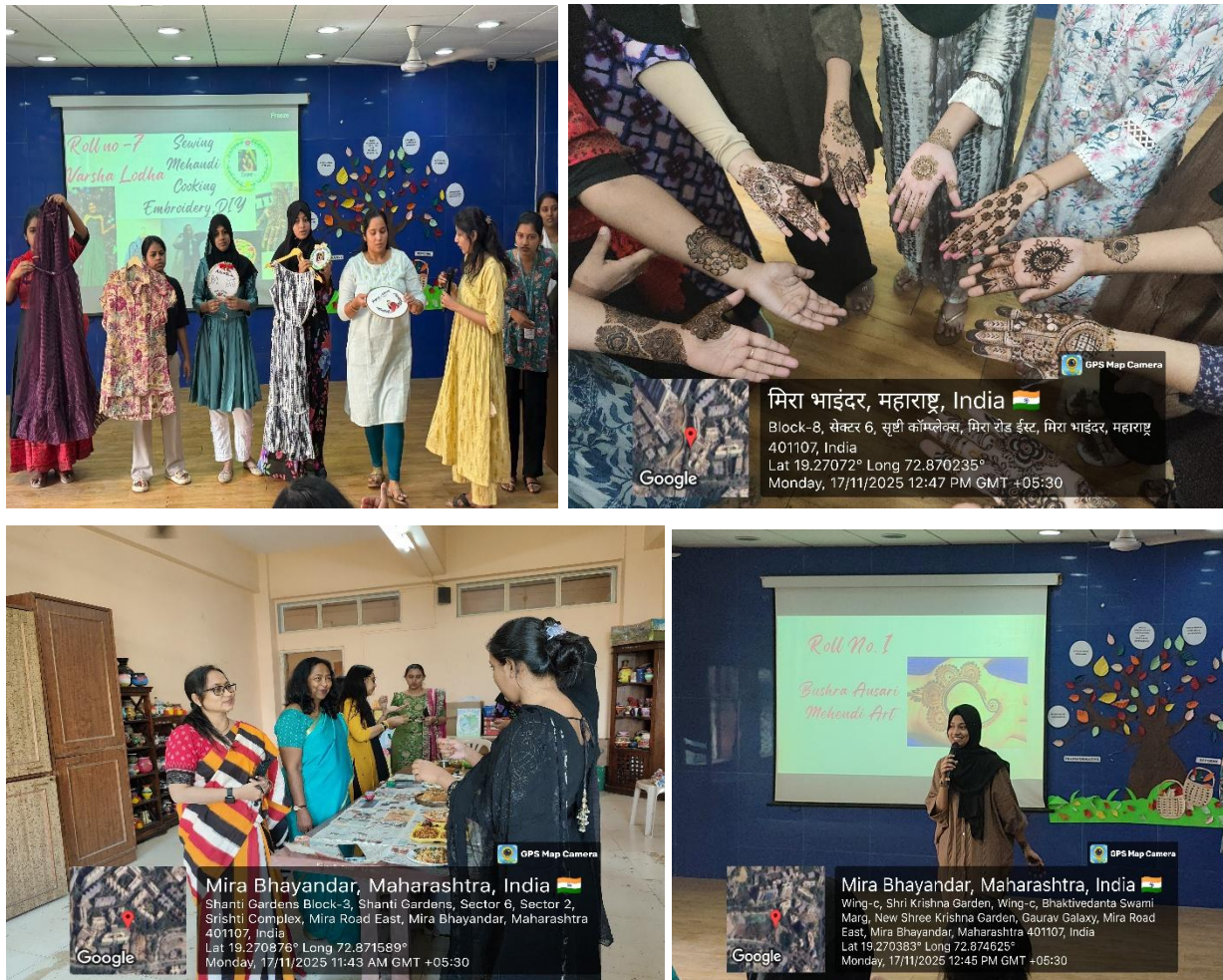


Talent Hunt- 17/11/2025, Venue: Multipurpose Hall
