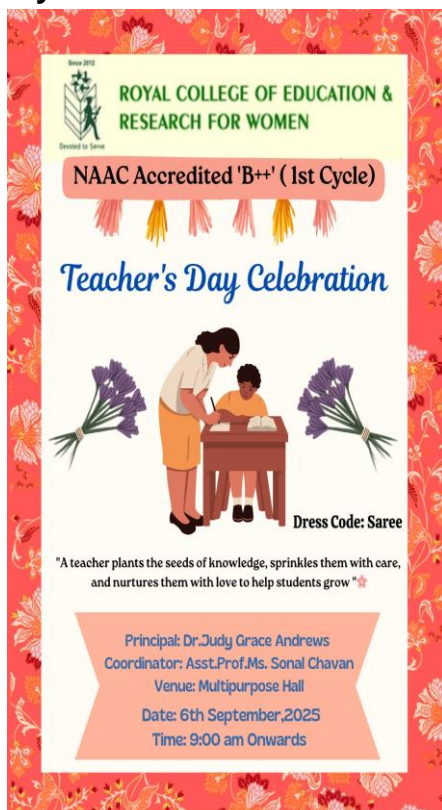
Learning outcomes:

5. A sense of respect, gratitude, and bonding was fostered between teachers and student-teachers.

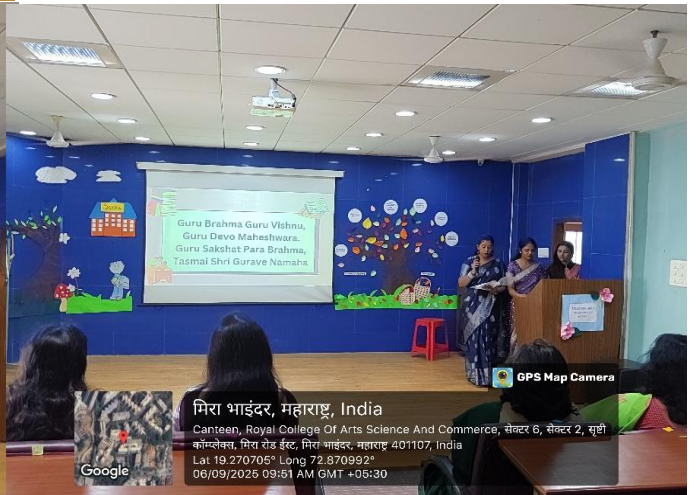
Feedback:
