The campaign saw active participation from students and faculty members. The collective Integrity Pledge and poster making activity helps in fostering an ethical environment within the institution.

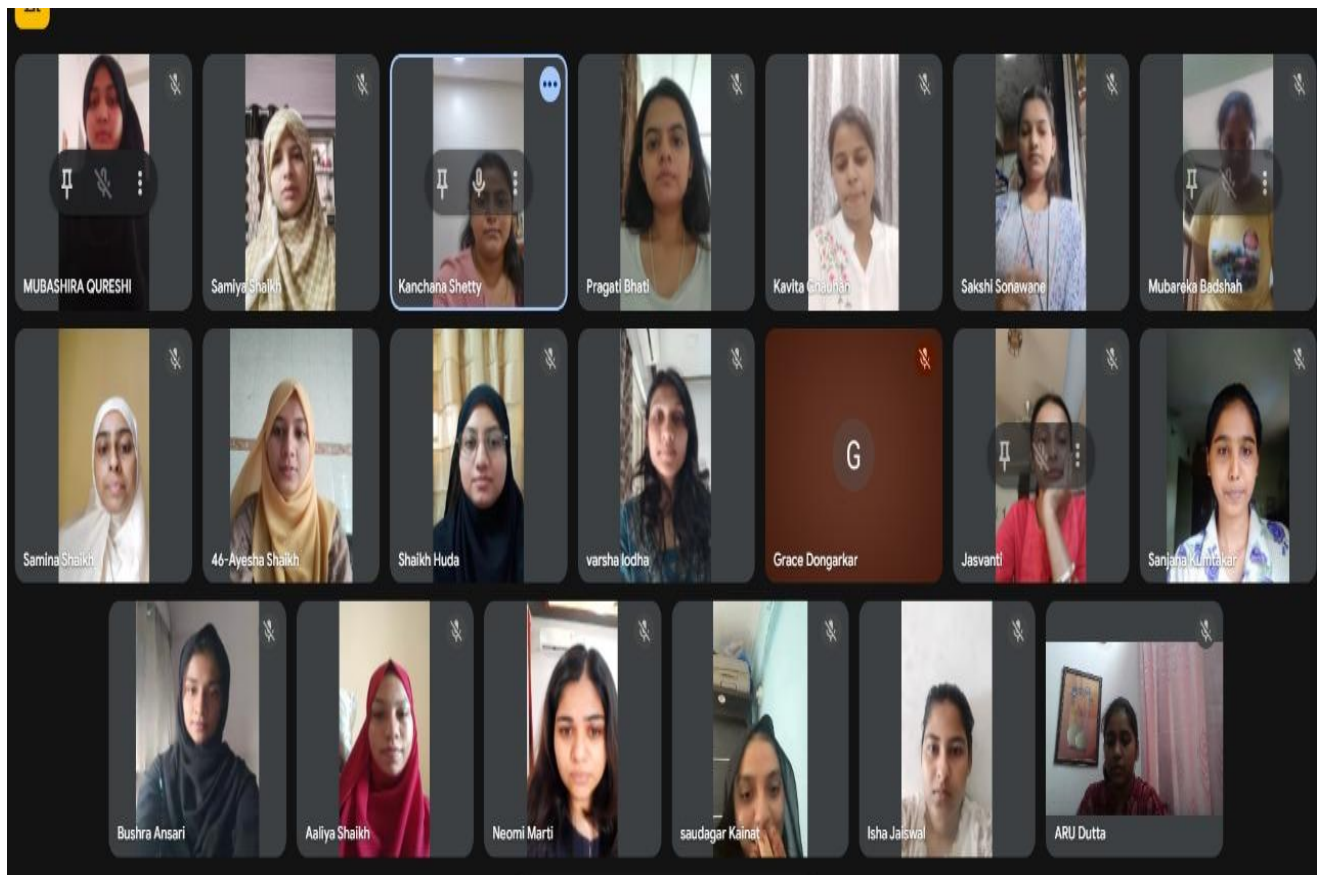
5. Outcomes of the Campaign
